**MICHIGAN RACQUETBALL
HALL OF FAME
CRITERIA**

1. The nominee must be 35 years of age or older.
2. The nominee must have been a resident in Michigan for at least 5 years.
3. The nominee must have been involved, one way or another, in racquetball for at least 10 years, of which 5 years must have been in Michigan.
4. The nominee must have conducted himself or herself in the best interest of racquetball and must be in good standing with the sanctioned State Association and the racquetball National Association.
5. The nominee cannot be nominated by himself or herself.
6. The nominee may not be nominated more than 5 times total.
7. The person submitting the nomination must submit a readable letter, or email, about the person to be nominated.
8. Anyone may nominate one person per year to the Michigan Racquetball Hall of Fame.
9. Anyone who has already been inducted into a national racquetball hall of fame (USAR & NMRA), is AUTOMATICALLY eligible to be inducted into the Michigan Racquetball Hall of Fame providing this person meets criteria numbers one through four above.
